

PERSONAL VEHICLE MAINTENANCE: Occasionally, we see UH parking spaces littered with auto parts and accessories. Auto maintenance in UH parking lots is not permitted for safety reasons. Per EPA NPDES Permit #WAS026611, all engine maintenance must be performed within an indoor garage in order to reduce storm water pollution.



LONG TERM PARKING: When going on deployment or going away for more than 90 days, all residents are required to check out. You cannot leave your vehicle in the UH parking lots. However, a long term parking spot, located next to the gym, is available for you at no cost. You have to register your vehicle at NAS Whidbey Island Quarterdeck located in Bldg. 385.
