UNAUTHORIZED ITEMS IN AND/OR AROUND UNACCOMPANIED HOUSING-FACILITIES

Alcoholic beverages.

Consumption restricted to private rooms and/or Commanding Officer (CO) designated lounges, picnic areas and/or common area kitchens.

In shared rooms with residents less than 21 years of age, secure alcoholic beverages when resident who is 21 or older is not present.

Alcohol consumption restricted for personnel less than 21 years of age.

No alcoholic beverages in glass containers in designated common areas approved by CO.

Empty bottle of alcohol will not be displayed as trophies.

Excessively worn and/or faded clothing to include clothing that may be offensive to others.

Sleepwear in common areas must be appropriate, no lingerie, undergarments, or revealing garments.

Automobile parts of any kind inside UH rooms.

Personal BBQ Grills, hibachis, etc. in or around UH buildings.

Gasoline, Coleman fuel, charcoal lighter fluid, charcoal, or other flammable and toxic fluids and gasses with the exception of combustible hobby-type fluids, paint and gases (i.e., butane/propane for lighters) in one pint or less quantities kept in original containers.

Fish Tanks, Fish Bowls, Aquariums, No Pets.

Con't. UNAUTHORIZED ITEMS IN AND OR AROUND UH FACILITIES

Diving tanks with a residual pressure above 14 PSI and limit of one tank per resident for tanks under 14 PSI.

Firearms, ammunition, gunpowder, any projectile emitting device (paintball guns, soft air rifles, potato guns, sling shots, bows and arrows, etc.), daggers, swords, knives and other stabbing instruments, or any other weapon capable of producing bodily harm..

Fireworks of any kind.

Fire pits, including free-standing fire pits, tiki torches or like items.

Open flame devices (i.e. candles, incense).

Flammables, except small quantities of lighter fluid, shoe polish, model paint, etc. for personal use.

Surge protectors and extension cords not UL rated.

Personal space heaters.

No visible profanity, pornographic, discriminatory or derogatory material to roommates, visitors or invited guests.

Personal furniture without prior UH office approval.

Other items not authorized due to health, life, and safety concerns or directed elsewhere.

Tips For Splitting Chores with Roommates

-Truthfully define your definition of clean early on. Setting expectations early on helps.
